

GHOSTWRITER ACTION STEP INTERIM 3

Professional ghostwriting is more intricate than merely researching a subject, interviewing an author, and writing a manuscript without taking a byline.

This action step is the third in a six-part series that introduces the analytical skills we use to attract premium clients.

- Action Step** Using the same uncomfortable nonfiction title (section 1) and novel (section 2) as last month, apply **debate protocol** to determine the work's content disruptions, if any.
- Explanation** We use debate protocol to:
1. Fully grasp the *opposite* core point
 2. Identify reader stops and disconnects
 3. Recognize potential negative-review elements
