

GHOSTWRITER ACTION STEP INTERIM 4

Professional ghostwriting is more intricate than merely researching a subject, interviewing an author, and writing a manuscript without taking a byline.

This action step is the fourth in a six-part series that introduces the analytical skills we use to attract premium clients.

Action Step	Using the same uncomfortable nonfiction title (section 1) and novel (section 2) as last month, apply abstract reasoning to determine structural issues.
Explanation	<p>We use abstract reasoning to determine:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Construction elements, i.e., fact, opinion, story, rhetoric, emotional lure/bait 2. Argument/example/illustration disconnects 3. Fiction plot holes, one-dimensional characters, and implausibilities 4. Nonfiction “missing dots” of information, context, and transitional bridges 5. Intrusive (non-constructive) redundancies
